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

THINK AND DO

Have students make a toss/catch toy. Each student will need a paper towel roll, hole punch, scissors, 20 inches (50 cm) of string or yarn, and a plastic lid at least 6 inches (15 cm) in diameter. Cut the center out of the lid. Punch a hole in one end of the paper tube. Tie the tube and ring together with the length of yarn. Hold the tube with the ring hanging down. Move the tube and try to catch the ring. Students can try to guess how many times they will catch the ring in ten attempts.
