### Coin Value

**Objective:** Students will identify coins by name and value (penny, nickel, dime, quarter).

#### **Preparation**

- 1. Assemble and laminate the Sand Treasures Game Board (pages 100 and 101).
- 2. Laminate and cut out the Sand Treasures Money Cards (page 103).
- 3. Laminate and cut out the Sand Pail Cover Ups (page 105).
- 4. Laminate the Sand Treasures Directions (page 97).
- 5. Store the Sand Treasures Money Cards and Sand Pail Cover Ups in a resealable storage bag. Label the bag with the game name label (page 175).
