Oh, isn't it a wonderful world, A wonderful world today?








#### Nature Picture



### Ready!

#### You will need:

- plastic tablecloth
- poster board
- non-toxic glue
- pie tin or other sturdy container
- craft sticks
- several brown paper bags
- · cookie sheet



#### Set, Go!

- Give your child a brown paper bag. Help her gather natural objects such as leaves, flowers, seed pods, sticks, and small pebbles from your backyard or a nearby park. Check these to make sure there is nothing dangerous or alive before your child handles them.
- 2. After returning home, place the natural objects on a cookie sheet. Provide poster board and glue. (Place glue in a pie tin or other container and use a craft stick to apply it.) Then your child can glue the natural objects on the poster board to make an interesting and colorful nature picture.

### Remember!

- Try this activity at several different times during the year so your child can make seasonal pictures using the natural objects.
- Talk with your child about the objects, and see how many of them she can name.
- These pictures will not last forever because of the natural materials used. However, your preschooler will enjoy making these pictures more than once.
