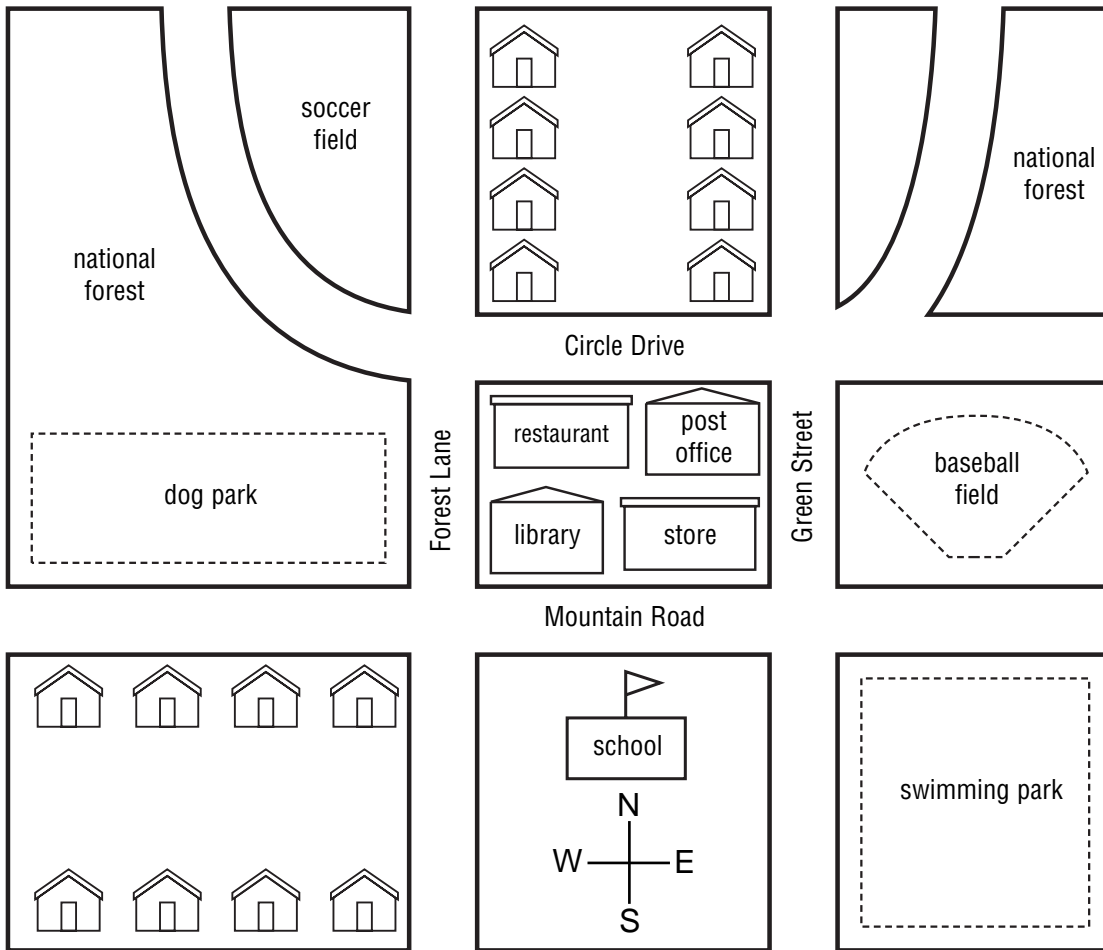

Use the map to answer the questions.

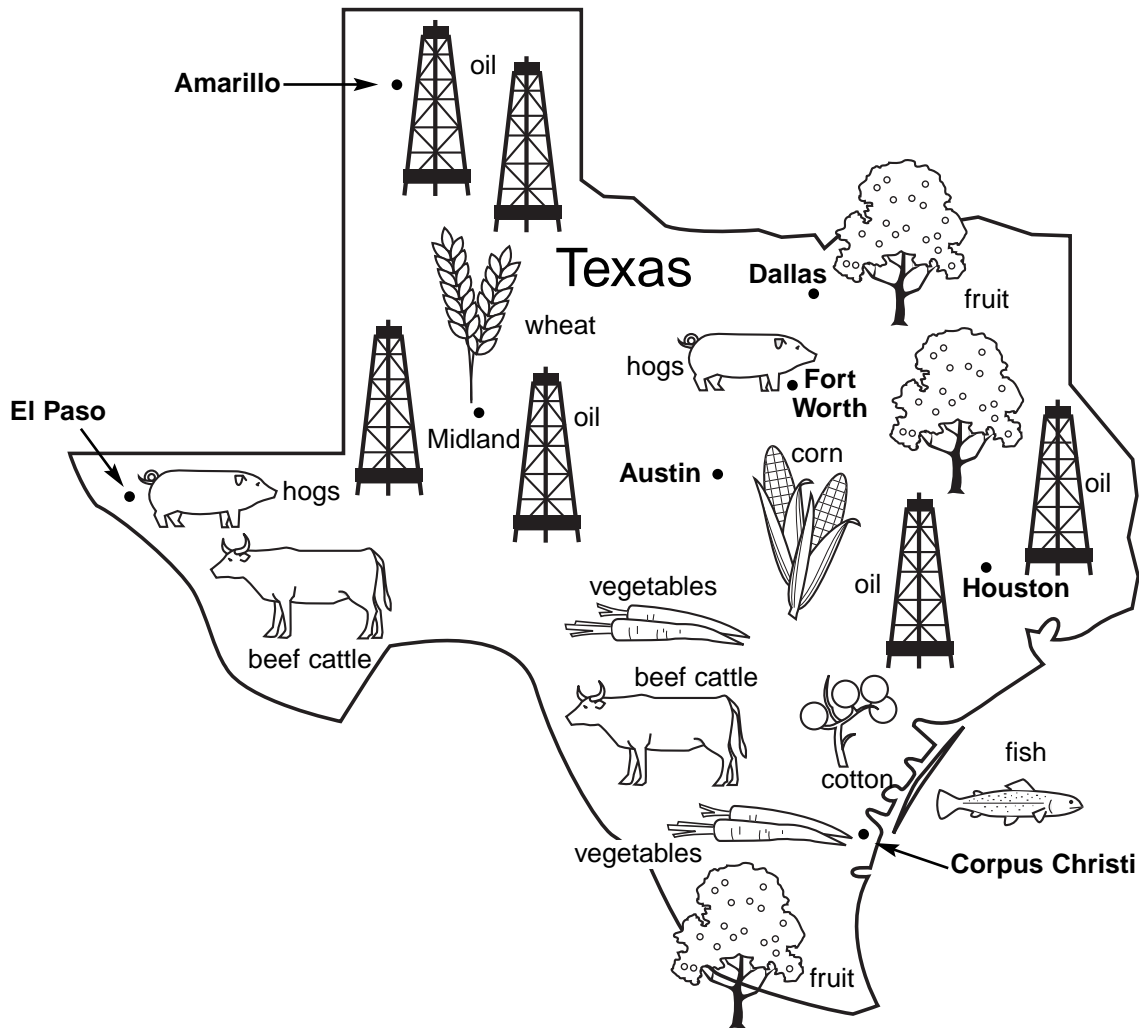
1. Which road is north of the school? _____
