



7-A is a word for picking up grain left behind by the harvesters of a crop. (Ruth 2:3)

Ruth picked up grain in the fields of <u>5-D</u>. (Ruth 2:3)

While Ruth was working in the field, she was also offered <u>4-D</u> to eat and <u>6-A</u> to drink. (Ruth 2:9, 14)

Ruth was amazed at the kindness shown to her, especially since she was a $\underline{\textbf{1-A}}$. (Ruth 2:10)


Boaz told Ruth she could find $\underline{\text{2-D}}$ in the God of Israel. (Ruth 2:12)
